


CUPO will also support the CESO "Volunteer Consultant" program by providing program and logistical support to the Ukrainian Canadian Congress and CESO, who manage these programs.

Volunteer-sending relates to five areas: Health, Agriculture, Public Administration, Civil Society and Private Sector and Enterprise Development. CUPO will also provide briefing and debriefing as well as logistical support to Canadian volunteers and Ukrainians involved in these programs. Upon request from the Canadian Embassy, CUPO will also provide support to Canada's bilateral cooperation program.

CUPO will also support Canada-Ukraine communication and promotional efforts by promoting and distributing a magazine called the Canada-Ukraine Monitor.
